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Economics: Tonnage estimates by Mr. Watt indicate about 5,000,000 yards of sand. Topography and location of deposit on crest of ridge is unfavorable for operation and would present difficulties in mining, and transportation to mill, which would have to be some distance downhill, near available water. The road to the property could be opened and improved at small cost.

Chrome content of sand, based on specific gravity and on appearance of sand, would be below 5% chromic oxide. Although the property might justify operation at some future date, the economics of it could not compare with those of other black sand deposits more favorably situated topographically and geographically.

Recommendations: Further testing and exploration of the deposit is not recommended, on the basis of chromite content.
