DODSON (JIM) GROUP (Molybdenite)
Upper Eagle Creek District

Location: Close to the line between Union and Baker counties, near the head and to the east of Copper Creek, a branch of Eagle Creek, in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of T. 5 S., R. 43 E.

Geology: It is reported that there is a zone 20 to 40 feet wide which shows disseminated molybdenite. In this zone is a smaller zone, a few feet wide, containing bunches of magnetite impregnated with molybdenite. *Pg 111-14A*
