

VEATCH CLAIM (Molybdenite)

Upper Eagle Creek District

Owner: R. S. Veatch, Portland, Oregon.

Location: Close to the line between Baker and Union counties, on the west side of Copper Creek, a tributary of Eagle Creek, in the SE. $\frac{1}{4}$ of T. 5 S., R. 43 E. The claim is west of the Dodson group.

Area: 1 claim.

Geology: Two veins are reported; No. 1 is 1 to 10 feet wide with an average of 3 feet of good grade molybdenite; No. 2 is from 2 to 6 feet wide of about the same grade as No. 1. The veins are parallel and about 200 feet apart.
