ANDY HEAVERNE'S CLAIM

Andy Heaverne's Claim.—About one and one-half miles below the Fraser property, and to the east of the stream, is located Andy Heaverne's claims in a limestone-granodiorite contact. The limestone here has approximately an east-west strike, with a high angle of dip to the north. The contact appears to be somewhat irregular and of less width than at Frasers, but considerable epidote and chalcopyrite are visible in the small amount of surface work accomplished. The lesser amount of contact-metamorphism may be due to a steeper angle of dip than found at Frasers.
