BUXTON COAL PROSPECT

Washington County

Location: On ^WWest fork of Dairy Creek, about 1 mile
air line west of Buxton, in ^{NE 1/4}sec. 6, T. 2 N., R.
4 W.

Miscellaneous: Coal is reported to outcrop in the creek,
and a short tunnel was dug in 1922 or 1923
in the south bank of the creek. The locality is reached
via ~~the Wolf Creek Highway~~ ^{Sunset} Highway to the foot of the hill west
of Buxton, thence on the old road up Dairy Creek (turn
left off the highway at the foot of the hill) about one mile,
~~to the meadow~~, where there is a large field between the
road and the creek to the south. The outcrop is in the
creek on the far side of the meadow.
