Dear Sir:

At the present time our entire capacity for normal ores and concentrates is fully committed and we are unable to offer you a market for this type of material.

However, we are interested in buying siliceous fluxing ores and, if any of your material would qualify in this category, we would appreciate receiving an analysis including gold, silver, copper, silica, iron, lime and alumina. Upon receipt of this information, we will advise you the ore's value and our interest in purchasing it.

We define siliceous fluxing ore as being in the order of 70% silica or higher, relatively low in iron and alumina, with enough value in gold, silver and copper to pay its way. We do not pay for silica as such, but will give you a lower treatment rate for this type of material.
