DOGAMI has concluded its comprehensive review of the Calico-Grassy Mountain Aquatic Resources baseline data reporting generated and submitted by the company to the State. As you know, previous editions of the Baseline Data Report (BDR) required revision.

On August 24, 2018, DOGAMI received the revised BDR for Aquatic Resources for the proposed Calico Resources mine in Malheur County. Aquatic Resources was included in the Environmental Baseline Study Work Plans dated September 22, 2017, approved with conditions by the State through the Technical Review Team in December 2017.
