Proposed Sumpter Cracker
Creek Gold Project
Notice of Intent (NOI) to submit a Consolidated Permit
Application (CPA)**

The Oregon Department of Geology and Mineral Industries (DOGAMI) has received a NOI for the proposed Sumpter Cracker Creek Gold Project. The applicant is: Sumpter Development LLC, 2605 Saddleback CT, Castle Rock, CO 80104.

The proposed Sumpter Cracker Creek project is in Baker County, Oregon, located approximately 6 miles north of Sumpter, Oregon. Sumpter Development LLC plans to reopen the Columbia, Eureka, Excelsior and North Pole Mines, and construct a modern 250-tonne gravity and floatation processing facility.

Under Oregon law (ORS 517.952 – ORS 517.989), a consolidated application process is used for administering state regulatory requirements for a surface or underground mine that processes, produces or reclaims metal ore using a method other than, or in addition to, gravity separation to process the ore. Most of the requirements are consolidated into permits issued by DOGAMI and other state permitting agencies. Additional federal, state, and/or local permits may be required.

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
