| <u>#5</u> 7992 | (Not charged by Schlumberger) Pea sized mud cake with dab of friable <u>Sandstone</u> -fine grained w/angular grains, sample too small to be of value. |
| <u>#6</u> 7990 | No recovery. |
| <u>#7</u> 7987 | (No charge) Pea sized small dab of very fine <u>sand</u> grains in a soft clayey matrix apparently not mud cake, sample too small to be of value. |
| <u>#8</u> 7985 | No recovery. |
| <u>#9</u> 7982 | No recovery. |
| <u>#10</u> 7978 | <u>SANDSTONE</u> - Friable, very fine to fine grained, arkosic, somewhat clayey, sparsely micaceous. (Sample is 1/4" x 3/4" x 1/8" in size.) |
| <u>#11</u> 7973 | No recovery. |
| <u>#12</u> 7970 | <u>SANDSTONE</u> - Friable, clayey, fine grained, poorly sorted, arkosic, sparsely micaceous. (1/4" cube sample size.) |

7305 CLAYEY SANDSTONE - Poor, small sample. Very fine grained poorly sorted, soft, arkosic sandstone. Appears weathered, angular grains of sand not easily separated from soft matrix or cementing material.

7306 (No charge) Nearly indistinguishable sample of few sand grains in a dab of mud.
