

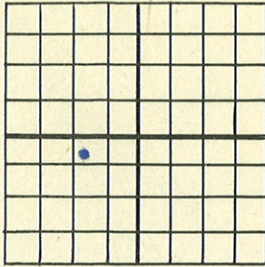

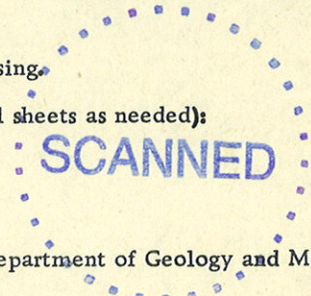
We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 750 feet.

We propose to drill with ~~cable~~ ^{rotary} tools.
