PLUGGING DETAILS

1. Ran in hole with 7 5/8 by 36" wood plug on wire line to 600'. Placed 1 sack of Diacel M and 1 sack of lime on top of plug.
2. 20 sacks of cement were placed on the plug at 600'.
3. Filled hole with heavy gel mud to surface.
4. Placed a 4 sack cement plug at the top of the 8" casing.
5. Cut 8" surfacing casing off 3 feet below ground level and welded a steel plate over the stub.
