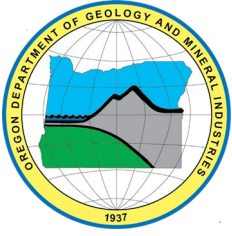

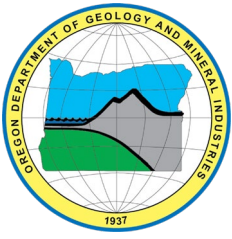

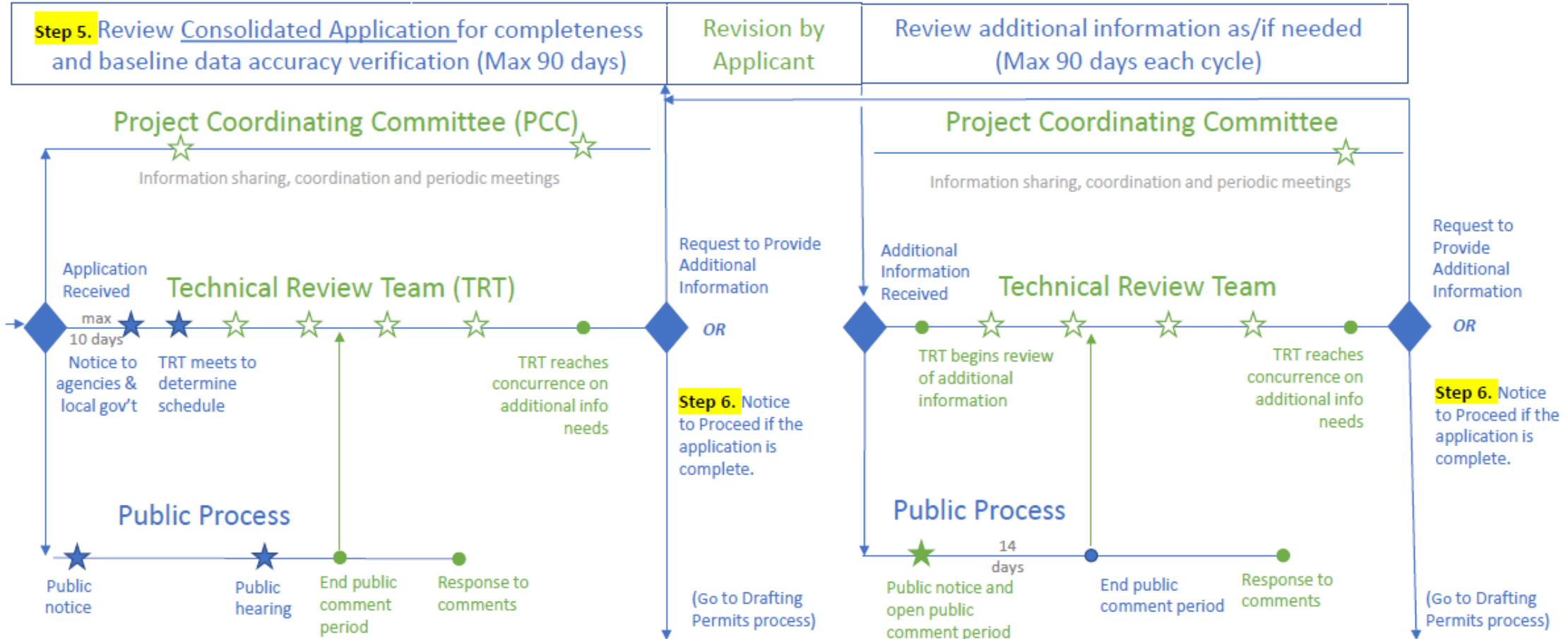


Phase 1: State Consolidated Application Process: Application Review

There are 10 key steps to the permitting process. To submit a consolidated application the first 4 steps must be completed:

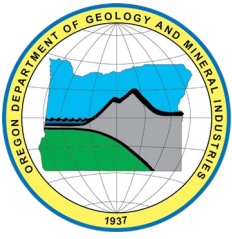
- Step 1.** Notice of Intent to submit a Consolidated Application.
- Step 2.** Notice of Applicant's Readiness to Collect Baseline Data.
- Step 3.** Collection of baseline data.
- Step 4.** Filing of a Consolidated Application including: operating plan, baseline data, reclamation & closure plan, alternatives analysis

The review and permitting process for the Consolidated Application includes steps 5-10 as shown in the following flow diagrams.
