Per [OAR 632-037-0080\(3\)](#), DOGAMI is accepting public comment on whether the information contained in the revised Groundwater Baseline Data Report (BDR; [https://www.oregongeology.org/mlrr/Calico-GrassyMtn\\_appResponseDocuments.htm](https://www.oregongeology.org/mlrr/Calico-GrassyMtn_appResponseDocuments.htm)), submitted by the Applicant in December 2021, is complete. Public comments will be accepted from noon May 11, 2022 to noon May 25, 2022. The Technical Review Team (TRT) Water Resources Subcommittee will conduct a meeting to discuss its findings following review of the BDR, which is scheduled for 2:00 pm – 4:00 pm (Pacific Standard Time [PST]) on May 25, 2022. In addition, the Water Resources Subcommittee will carry its motion forward to the TRT during a TRT meeting at a not yet established later date. The meetings will be held remotely, and do not have in-person access.

- The completeness review process is designed to avoid a situation where an agency would have to deny a permit *for lack of information*.
- Is the information contained in the BDR complete? Is the information sufficient to allow the agencies to issue or deny a permit? If not, please provide comments using the format below:
