Free use of computers

Free assistance

Employees from the Department of Revenue and volunteers from free tax assistance groups will be available to guide you through the new IRS Direct File and Direct File Oregon options.



E-file for free

By filing directly with the IRS and the Department of Revenue, you are able to complete your taxes and file electronically at no charge.

Both IRS Direct File and Direct File Oregon are mobile friendly, so you can complete your return on your phone or tablet, as well.

Set up an IRS online account and an account with Oregon's Revenue Online before you come to the event.

What to bring

- Social security card or ITIN for everyone on your tax return
- Government picture ID for taxpayer and spouse if filing jointly (driver's license or passport)
- Forms W-2 (wages from a iob)
- Forms 1099-G, 1099-R, 1099-INT (other income)
- Form SSA-1099 (Social Security Benefits)
- Canceled check or bank routing and account numbers for direct deposit
- Last year's tax return
