

Purpose

Use Form OR-706-V to mail your Oregon estate transfer tax payment to the department **without** Form OR-706. See Form OR-706 Instructions for more information.

Payment options

Mailed payments:

Make your check, money order, or cashier's check payable to the Oregon Department of Revenue. Write "Form OR-706-V," the decedent name, the decedent Social Security number (DSSN), the date of death, and a daytime phone for the executor on your payment. Don't mail cash.

Payments mailed with a return: If you're mailing a payment with Form OR-706, send the payment and return in the same envelope and **don't** use a voucher. See Form OR-706 Instructions for the mailing address to send your return and payment.

Payments mailed without a return: If you're mailing a payment without Form OR-706, mail the payment and voucher to:

Form OR-706-V instructions

Date of death. Enter the month, day, and year for the date of death.

Taxpayer information. Completely fill out the information on the form.

Payment type. Check the appropriate box for this payment.

Do you have an approved extension to pay? Check the "Prepayment" checkbox when filing Form OR-706-V with your payment.

Please note: This voucher isn't a request for an extension to file. The voucher identifies the payment type only. See Form OR-706-EXT Instructions for extension filing information.

Having trouble viewing this form? If you are viewing the voucher form electronically and you see a solid box instead of letters or numbers, adjust the view size to 100 percent and press the tab key to move through the fields.
