

Purpose

Use Form OR-TM-V when mailing a payment to the department without your Oregon TriMet Self-employment return. See Form OR-TM Instructions for more information.

Payment options

Online payments:

You can make payments anytime at www.oregon.gov/dor. Don't use Form OR-TM-V with online payments.

Payments with a return:

If you're mailing a payment with your tax return, send the payment and return in the same envelope and **don't** use Form OR-TM-V. We accept checks, money orders, and cashier's checks. Don't mail cash. See Form OR-TM Instructions for the mailing address to send your return and payment.

Payments without a return:

If you're mailing a payment without a return, mail your check, money order, or cashier's check with Form OR-TM-V to:

Don't combine your TriMet self-employment tax payment with any other tax payment. Make your check or money order payable to the Oregon Department of Revenue. Write the following on your payment: Social Security number (SSN) or federal employer identification number (FEIN), the tax year beginning and ending dates, and a daytime phone number. Don't mail cash.

Form OR-TM-V instructions

Tax year: Enter the month, day, and year for the beginning and end date of the tax year you are submitting the payment for.

Taxpayer information: Completely fill out the information on the form.

- Individual filer: Enter your SSN if you're an individual sole proprietor or a member of a partnership and choose to file your own individual transit return. **Note:** Don't include the FEIN if you're filing as an individual.
- Partnership filer: Enter your FEIN and participating members on one return.

If your address has changed since the last time you filed a return, send a separate letter requesting a change of address or update online at www.oregon.gov/dor. Your address will not be updated using information on Form OR-TM-V.

Payment type: Check the appropriate box for the type of payment being made.

Note: This voucher isn't an extension to file. Oregon accepts the federal extension. If you need an Oregon-only extension, fill out the federal extension form and write "For Oregon only" at the top. When you file your return on extension, check the "Extension to file" box on the Oregon return. Don't send the extension with your return; keep it with your tax records.
