**SUBJECT:** Private Security and Investigator Policy Committee (PSIPC) -  
Private Investigator Subcommittee Vacancies

The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST) is accepting letters of interest for three vacancies on the Private Security and Investigator Policy Committee (PSIPC) Private Investigator Subcommittee.

The Private Investigator Subcommittee members must be licensed private investigators in the state of Oregon and will represent the private investigator community.

The Private Investigator Subcommittee is responsible for developing and recommending to the PSIPC for approval, policies, requirements, standards, and rules relating to the private investigation discipline. Subcommittee recommendations are submitted to the PSIPC and, if approved, to the Board on Public Safety Standards and Training (Board) for consideration.

The subcommittee will meet as determined by the subcommittee in coordination with the PSIPC and the Board. Members of subcommittee may be eligible for reimbursement of costs incurred traveling to and from meetings.

The term of an appointed member is two years, and a member may be appointed to a second two-year term. Applications for membership received by DPSST will be presented to the PSIPC chairperson for consideration.
