John Minnis reported on DPSST grants and explained there is a very slim budget for future grant requests.

Eriks Gabliks gave an update on the current legislative session.

House Bill 2790 – BPSST and Policy Committee Re-Organization, Change in Revocation/Denial

Chair Bentz asked if anyone had further input or proposed changes. Rosie Sizer proposed putting the matter to a vote for Board approval. Several members had not had the opportunity to discuss or review the amendment with their peers and were unsure about their stance. The proposal was not moved forward.

### **6. Committee Reports**

- Corrections Policy Committee – Todd Anderson, Chair  
The committee has finished up last year’s old OAR cases.

The new curriculum committee, headed up by Steve Winegar, is underway and waiting to see how the budget will affect the academy and training. The curriculum being developed covers county and city, but they're waiting to see what happens with SB 257 (the bill that would remove DOC training from DPSST).

The committee reviewed their first revocation and denial cases.
- Police Policy Committee – Andrew Bentz, Chair  
The committee is keeping an eye on the budget and has a heavy agenda coming up.
- Private Security Policy Committee – Jeff Martin, Chair  
The committee is following the progress of a couple of bills.  
There are two vacancies on the committee to be filled.
- Telecommunications Policy Committee – Eriks Gabliks for Rob Poirier, Chair  
The committee is working on curriculum updates.  
NIMS training is available online which allows trainers to recapture some student time at the academy.
