

Board on Public Safety Standards and Training

1. Minutes of November 10 and November 28, 2011 meetings

The February 9, 2012 meeting was cancelled.

John Klum moved to approve the minutes as written. Jeff Martin seconded the motion. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

2. OAR 259-008-0068 – Proposed Rule

Retired Police Officer

Linsay Hale reviewed the rule and Marilyn Lorange reviewed the background for the committee.

Jeff Martin moved to approve repealing OAR 259-008-0068. John Klum seconded the motion. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

By consensus, the committee determined there is no significant fiscal impact on small business.

3. OAR 259-008-0070 – Proposed Rule

Denial/Revocation

Linsay Hale reviewed the rule for the committee.

Jeff Martin moved to approve filing the proposed language for OAR 259-008-0070 with the Secretary of State as a proposed rule and as a permanent rule if no comments are received. John Klum seconded the motion. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

By consensus, the committee determined there is no significant fiscal impact on small business.

4. Fallen Law Enforcement Officer Memorial Wall Nomination

Officer Buddy Ray Herron – Oregon Department of Corrections – EOCI

Director Gabliks reviewed the background for the committee. The Corrections Policy Committee unanimously approved adding Officer Herron's name to the memorial wall at their February 14, 2012 meeting. The Public Safety Memorial Fund Board awarded death benefits to the family.

John Klum moved to approve the addition of Officer Herron's name to the memorial wall. Diana Simpson seconded the motion. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

5. Budget Update

DPSST held a meeting today to announce the 3.5% budget reduction and the impact to staff. The agency will lose five full-time and one part-time position, as well as the Child Abuse Training Program. The layoffs are effective April 1, 2012. The Fire Program, 9-1-1, and Private Security Programs were not affected by the budget reductions.

6. Legislative Update

Director Gabliks reported on SB412. The fix to the rule was addressed and passed by the Legislature.

Some of the state judicial employees will be trained as law enforcement officers under DPSST statutes. Marilyn will be working to bring them up to speed.

PS/PI bouncer clarification was needed and has not been equally applied. The rule has been cleaned up and was moved through the Legislature.

OLCC agents performing investigative and enforcement services will now be certified and trained by DPSST. They will be their own entity and have separate training, as these officers will not be armed, but will come under the purview of the Police Policy Committee for revocation and denial cases as they have limited peace officer authority.

7. General Information

Director Gabliks Eriks reviewed the new Board and committee members coming up at the April 26 Board meeting.
