This letter is sent in compliance with ORS 181A.686, to report discipline imposing an economic sanction to DPSST.

Name/rank of officer disciplined: Jesse Unck, Detective (DPSST #51000)
Employing agency: Clackamas County Sheriff's Office

Discipline Imposed: 40-hour suspension without pay

Description of the facts underlying the discipline imposed:

Over the period of several months and on multiple occasions, the above-mentioned employee failed to properly account for work, sick and vacation time. The employee took various days off of work without completing and submitting a time adjustment form. The employee also violated agency policy by improperly flexing time.

A law enforcement agency from outside the county was requested to investigate whether there was evidence of criminal wrongdoing. Their criminal investigation was submitted to the Clackamas County District Attorney's (DA) Office for review. The DA's Office assessed the case and agreed with the opinion of the investigator that there was not sufficient evidence to conclude the employee had acted in a criminal manner, or had knowingly violated any statute relating to the office for which he serves.

Following the conclusion of the criminal investigation and the District Attorney's declination, the Clackamas County Sheriff's Office Professional Standards Unit conducted an administrative investigation to determine whether the employee's conduct violated Sheriff's Office Policy 13: Performance of Duties in a Competent Manner. Evidence of a Policy 13 violation was sustained and discipline was imposed as reflected in this record.
