- Current Fit test for SCBA mask used
- Physical exam by physician
- Ability to become certified as a Firefighter in the State of Oregon
- PPE to meet NFPA standards
- Duty uniform will be worn daily
- Attendees will bring their own department gear, and 2 SCBA Tanks.
