

Private Security Providers Moral Fitness Standards

Effective January 1, 2021

MANDATORY DISQUALIFIERS (ALL PROVIDERS) – MUST DENY/REVOKE OR REFUSE TO RENEW
ORS 137.700 FELONY CONVICTION or an equivalent in another jurisdiction. (MEASURE 11 CRIMES*) <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If certified or licensed = revocation or refuse to renew• If an applicant = denial, UNLESS TEN years have passed from the final date of completion of all court ordered obligations (all imprisonment, parole, probation and post-prison supervision).
Conviction of a crime for any offense, other than the mandatory grounds defined above, for which a maximum term of imprisonment of more than one year may be imposed under the law of the jurisdiction where the conviction occurred. Generally, all other felony convictions. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If certified or licensed = revocation or refuse to renew• If an applicant = denial, UNLESS FOUR years have passed from the final date of completion of all court ordered obligations (all imprisonment, parole, probation and post-prison supervision).
REQUIRED TO REGISTER OR IS REGISTERED AS A SEX OFFENDER UNDER ORS 163A.010, 163A.015, 163A.020 OR 163A.025. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If certified or licensed = revocation or refuse to renew• If an applicant = denial
*MEASURE 11 CRIMES – INCLUDES: Attempt or Conspiracy to Commit Aggravated Murder, Murder in the second degree, Murder in the first degree, Attempt or Conspiracy to Commit Murder in any degree, Manslaughter in the First Degree, Manslaughter in the Second Degree, Aggravated Vehicular Homicide, Assault in the Second Degree, Assault in the First Degree, Kidnapping in the Second Degree, Kidnapping in the First Degree, Rape in the Second Degree, Rape in the First Degree, Sodomy in the Second Degree, Sodomy in the First Degree, Sexual Penetration in the Second Degree, Sexual Penetration in the First Degree, Sexual Abuse in the First Degree, Using a Child in a Display of Sexually Explicit Conduct, Arson in the First Degree, Robbery in the Second Degree, Robbery in the First Degree, and Compelling Prostitution.
ADDITIONAL MANDATORY DISQUALIFIERS FOR ARMED PROFESSIONALS & FIREARMS INSTRUCTORS <u>ONLY</u> MUST DENY/REVOKE OR REFUSE TO RENEW
Failure to meet the minimum standards for armed certification as an armed private security professional or a private security firearms instructor pursuant to OAR 259-060-0020. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If certified = revocation or refuse to renew• If an applicant = denial

ADDITIONAL DISCRETIONARY DISQUALIFIERS (ALL PROVIDERS) – MAY DENY/REVOKE OR REUSE TO RENEW
Falsifying any information submitted on the application for certification or licensure or any documents submitted to the Department pertaining to private security certification or licensure.
Failure to meet or failure to comply with any provisions found in the Act or the rules.
Failure to pay a civil penalty or fee imposed by the Board when due.
