

Compliance Bulletin – Q4 2013

Oregon Private Security & Private Investigator Moral Fitness

The Private Security Certification and Private Investigator Licensing programs are mandated by the Oregon legislature to establish and enforce minimum standards for all private security professionals and private investigators in the state. The minimum standards for each program are defined in Oregon Administrative Rule Divisions 60 & 61.

This quarterly review of applicants and providers who violated those minimum standards is meant to provide insight into the types of disqualifiers that DPSST is seeing in revocation, denial, or suspension of certification and licensure. The following cases are *some* of the circumstances that have resulted in consideration of **revocation, denial or suspension** of certifications and/or licenses by DPSST the last quarter.

The Department continues to ensure that certified private security professionals and private investigators meet the minimum standards established by the legislature.

Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Aggravated Unlawful Use of Weapon/Vehicle, Retail Theft and Battery.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider charged with Sexual Abuse 1-2 counts.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Felony Assault IV, DV and Theft 3.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider convicted of Theft 1-Four Counts.
Unarmed Professional and Unarmed Instructor	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant admitted to inappropriate contact with a female inmate while a corrections officer.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant had a pattern of arrests for possession of a controlled substance, Menacing, Recklessly Endangering, Harassment, and Contempt of Court.
Armed/Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant admitted to theft. Juvenile background indicates a long history of arrests with no convictions.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Credit Card Abuse and Theft 2.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant arrested for theft. Two separate incidents. Although both reduced to violations, the applicant admitted to the thefts.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant arrested for Theft 2. Charge was dismissed, but applicant admitted to the theft and told police he had a problem with taking things that did not belong to him.

Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant has a pattern of three or more arrests in the last 10 years.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant was convicted of Theft 2.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant was convicted of Assault with intent to inflict GBI and Interfere w/Public Transport.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider failed to notify DPSST of two separate charges for non-disqualifying crime. Did not respond to the notice of stipulation sent.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Theft 2 and Menacing.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider was arrested and charged with Theft 3. She failed to appear in court and was sent a letter from DPSST with instructions to resolve the warrant. She did not respond.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider was convicted of Burglary 2.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Theft 2.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant is required to register as a sex offender.

Alarm Monitor Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Robbery 3rd degree.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Although in diversion, the applicant admitted to Theft of beer and grocery items.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Unlawful Possession of a Firearm.
Alarm Monitor Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Wanton Endangerment of a Police Officer.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Provider pled guilty, with conditional discharge to possession of methamphetamine.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Provider pled guilty, with conditional discharge to possession of cocaine.
Alarm Monitor Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Battery.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Manslaughter 2.
Unarmed Professional H.	Mandatory	Provider convicted of Burglary 2.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant required to register as a sexual offender.

Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider convicted of Harassment-Constituting Domestic Violence.
Armed/Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Provider arrested for Theft 1. Admitted to stealing 55K from employer.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant worked in law enforcement and was unable to account for expenditures for confidential informants.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant does not meet minimum standards. No High School Diploma or GED.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider convicted of 3 counts of child rape and 2 counts of child molestation in the first degree.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Burglary 1, crime category 9.
Alarm Monitor Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of aggravated assault with a gun.
Unarmed Professional	Emergency Suspension	Provider was arrested and charged with Assault 3 for striking a Tri-Met bus driver.
Unarmed Professional	Emergency Suspension	Provider charged with 3 counts of Theft 1.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Theft 3 and Initiating a False Report.
Supervisory Manager and Unarmed Professional	Emergency Suspension	Provider charged with Rape 2, Sodomy, Sexual Abuse 1, Compelling Prostitution, and Delivering Marijuana to a person.
Armed/Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider convicted of Coercion, crime category 7 and Assault 4, Constituting Domestic Violence.
