

Compliance Bulletin – Q1 2014

Oregon Private Security & Private Investigator Moral Fitness

The Private Security Certification and Private Investigator Licensing programs are mandated by the Oregon legislature to establish and enforce minimum standards for all private security professionals and private investigators in the state. The minimum standards for each program are defined in Oregon Administrative Rule Divisions 60 & 61.

This quarterly review of applicants and providers who violated those minimum standards is meant to provide insight into the types of disqualifiers that DPSST is seeing in revocation, denial, or suspension of certification and licensure. The following cases are *some* of the circumstances that have resulted in consideration of **revocation, denial or suspension** of certifications and/or licenses by DPSST the last quarter.

The Department continues to ensure that certified private security professionals and private investigators meet the minimum standards established by the legislature.

Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider convicted of Endangering the Welfare of a Minor Child-2 Counts.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Theft 3
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Applicant arrested as juvenile for Assault 1. Moral Fitness, Lack of Good Character, Mistreatment of Others, Lack of Public Trust.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Applicant disloyal to employer. Violated an inmate's rights as a corrections officer. Moral Fitness, Lack of Good Character, Mistreatment of Others, Lack of Public Trust.

Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider convicted of Unlawful Possession of a Firearm.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant arrested for Assault 2 after he severely beat and kicked an elderly man in a parking lot. Victim refused to move forward with the case.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Theft 1.
Alarm Monitor Professional	Mandatory	Applicant was convicted of Unlawful Possession of Cannabis.
Alarm Monitor Professional	Discretionary	Applicant arrested for Theft. Although charges were dismissed, police reports support that theft occurred.
Alarm Monitor Professional	Mandatory	Provider charged with Attempt to Commit Murder, Assault in the 2nd Degree, Assault in 4th Degree, Strangulation, Menacing, and Recklessly Endangering Another Person.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider charged with Recklessly Endangering Another and Unlawful Discharge of Firearm.

Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider charged with Identity Theft, Tampering with Drug Records. Expired, and then reapplied. Convicted of Theft of Identity

Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Lack of Moral Fitness. Provider was charged with Burglary 1, Assault 4 DV, Menacing and Strangulation. Pled guilty to Assault 4 and entered Deferred sentencing program.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Provider was terminated from his employment for theft. He used security keys to access food services after hours and video confirms he stole food and drinks from his employer.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted in California of Grand Theft Money, Labor, Property after she stole from her employer.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant falsified his application when he did not disclose the revocation of his criminal justice certifications. Lack of Good Character and Lack of Public Trust for the events leading to the revocation of his police officer certificate.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant had sex and exchanged texts and videos of a sexual nature with a female victim of domestic violence that he met in the course of his duty as a police officer.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant was convicted of resisting arrest.

Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant had four separate incidents, two of them involving drugs, while serving in the military that ultimately led to his discharge.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Felony Unlawful Possession of Marijuana.
Unarmed Professional	Emergency Suspension	Provider charged with Unlawful Use of Weapon against Another.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Provider charged with Burglary 2 and Theft 2-Three counts each when he stole cash while protecting a neighboring property. Dismissed in civil compromise. Moral fitness, dishonesty, lack of good character, lack of public trust.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant admitted to theft of government property while serving in the military.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Recklessly Endangering-2 Counts.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant shows a pattern of arrests in the last two years for Assault 4, Harassment, Disorderly Conduct and Interfering with a police officer. All charges but harassment were dismissed.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant shows a pattern or arrests since 2012. Assault 4, DUI, DWS, Assault 4 and DWS. Convicted only of DUI and DWS. Mitigation provided and accepted. Department withdrew request to deny.

Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Attempting to Elude Police, Recklessly Endangering and Carrying of Concealed Weapon.
Unarmed Professional	Emergency Suspension	Provider charged with Rape 1, Assault 2, and Felony Assault IV.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Carry Concealed/Possession of a Firearm.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Provider arrested for Felony Theft 1. Stole 9K in merchandise from employer while employed in loss prevention.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Moral Fitness. Applicant shows a pattern of arrests for assault, harassment, resisting arrest, and PCS.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider convicted of Unlawful Possession of Marijuana
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Provider convicted of misdemeanor DUI involving the use and possession of drugs.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Provider arrested for manipulating a gas pump, while employed with gas station, to lower the price, and then fill up his personal vehicle. Two incidents
Armed/Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of Vandalism in another jurisdiction. Damage in excess of 4K. Equal to Criminal Mischief 2 in Oregon.
Unarmed Professional	Mandatory	Applicant convicted of a misdemeanor involving the unlawful use, possession, delivery or manufacture of a controlled substance, narcotic or dangerous drug.
Unarmed Professional	Discretionary	Applicant does not meet moral fitness standards including multiple arrests for Disorderly Conduct, Interfering with a police officer, Recklessly Endangering, DUII x2 and Assault 4.

Executive Manager	Civil Penalty \$2,000	Provider assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000 for employing an individual to provide private security services without proper certification and \$1,000 for falsifying a PS-20.
Executive Manager	Civil Penalty \$1,000	Provider assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000 for employing an individual to provide private security services and never processing an application packet for the individual.
Executive Manager	Civil Penalty \$4,000	Provider assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$4,000 for employing multiple individuals to provide private security services without proper certification during multiple months.
Executive Manager	Civil Penalty \$1,000	Provider assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000 for employing individuals to provide private security services without proper certification; one of which was disqualified previously.
Executive Manager	Civil Penalty \$1,000	Provider assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000 for employing an individual to provide private security services without proper certification.
