RULE SUMMARY: OAR 259-008-0500 is adopted to designate which accrediting bodies a law enforcement agency in this state may use to obtain the accreditation required by House Bill 2162 from the 2021 Legislative Session.

CHANGES TO RULE:

Law Enforcement Agency Accreditation

The Department designates the following bodies as accrediting bodies for the purpose of accrediting law enforcement agencies in this state:

(1) The Oregon Accreditation Alliance; and

(2) The Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA).
