

State Land Board Meeting Summary – April 10, 2018

The Land Board approved the Consent Agenda.

Informational Item

The Land Board received an update and the annual report on Common School Fund investments and distributions for fiscal year 2017. The report was prepared by the Oregon State Treasury.

Action Items

- Request to sell the 159-acre Millican Road property in Crook County
- Request to initiate budget limitation requests at the May 2018 Emergency Board meeting
