

State Land Board Meeting Summary – June 12, 2018

At the beginning of the meeting, board members presented the annual Land Board Awards:

- Stream Project Award: Willamette Confluence Restoration project (Eugene-Springfield)
- Partnership Award: Tenmile Lakes Basin Partnership (Coos and Douglas counties)

The board also recognized two Department of State Lands staff:

- Gerry Hutson, proprietary coordinator, received the first Common School Fund Champion award for her efforts to find \$50,000 for the fund
- Julie Curtis, public information manager, on her retirement after 30 years of service with the State of Oregon
