What DSL Customers Need to Know

DSL's offices in Salem and Bend are closed to the public. In-person services are being provided by appointment only. Walk-in services are no longer available. South Slough Reserve is open with limited programming and access to facilities. Hiking and waterway trails are open to the public. Restrooms are open on the weekdays from 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. Visitors are asked to clean up after their dogs and themselves. The Visitor Center remains closed until further notice. Some community classes, events, and school programs are happening once more; however, we are not hosting events hosted by third parties at this time.
