Quarterly OGIC Meeting Recap

In July, OGIC held its third quarterly council meeting of 2025. July's council meeting was held virtually. The <u>meeting packet</u> and <u>recording</u> are available online.

Meeting Actions

OGIC voted and approved one (1) item during the quarterly council meeting:

Public Body Data Sharing

OGIC's Data Sharing and Governance committee continues to consult with agencies regarding Framework data elements. Three (3) agencies have successfully completed consultation as outlined in OGIC's Administrative Process and Procedures to Implement ORS 276A.509.

Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, Oregon Department Transportation, and Oregon State Fire Marshall's Office completed the consultation and accounted for 18 Framework data elements that OGIC designated for Public Body Data Sharing with a unanimous vote.

Oregon's Framework Program currently consists of 168 data elements. Currently OGIC has completed consultation with 49 data elements; further coordination is required for 84 data elements; and 35 data elements are exempt from OGIC's process.
