Widgets

Creating and Managing Within Investments in the Modern UX





You can create/manage Widgets to any Grid view that supports Widgets. There are five (5) Widget Types:

- **Number Tile:** Displays a specific number based on the widget definition and filter criterion

- **Pie:** Displays a pie chart based on the widget definition and filter criterion

All but the Number Tile Widgets enables you to select a relevant Group by attribute and an Aggregation attribute (Count, Sum, Average, Min and Max).

- **Bar:** Displays a bar graph based on the widget definition and filter criterion

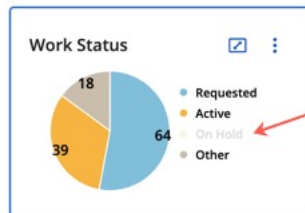
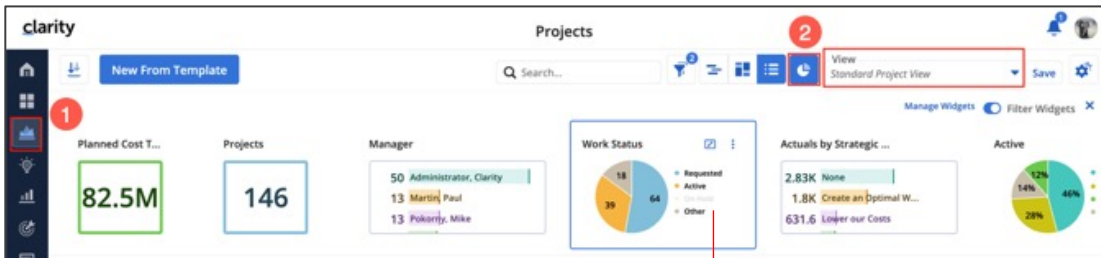
- **Progress Ring:** Displays a ring with a number based on the widget definition and filter criterion

- **Target (Roadmaps Only):** Displays targets either as **goals** or **constraints** on the number and money attributes of the Roadmap Item object

Creating Widgets

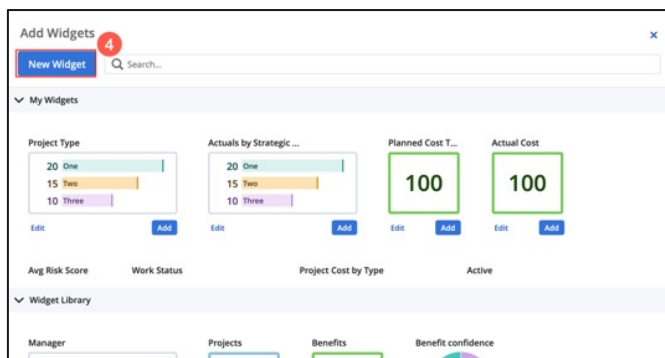
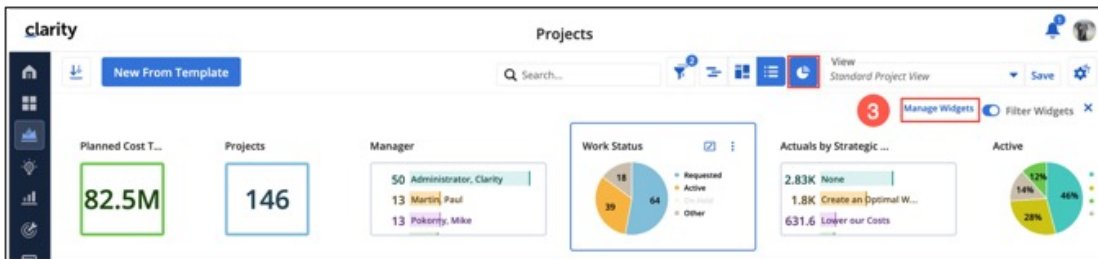


1. Navigate to the Grid that supports Widgets (Ideas, Projects, Custom Investments, Staff, Risks, etc.)
2. Click on the **Show Widgets** button
 - a. When Widgets are saved with the View, the display at the top of the page



Click attributes in the Legend to hide/display those values

3. Click **Manage Widgets**. The **Add Widgets** dialog box displays.
 - a. When the **Filter Widgets** is enabled, the Widget results is based on the filter that is part of the View





4. Click New Widget

5. Select the Widget type and click Next

6. Enter the Details

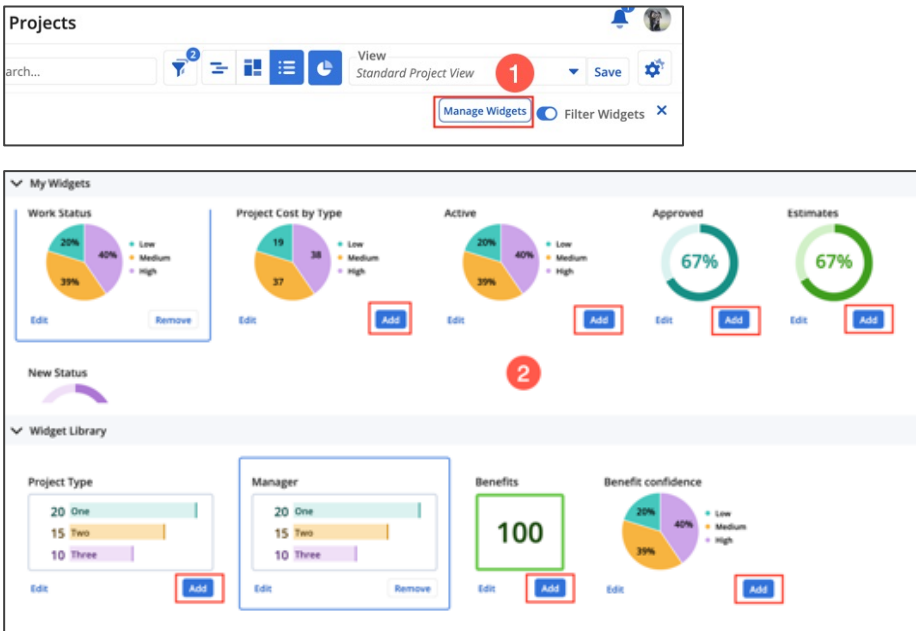
a. Click In the **Widget Library** to allow other users to access the Widget

7. Click Create

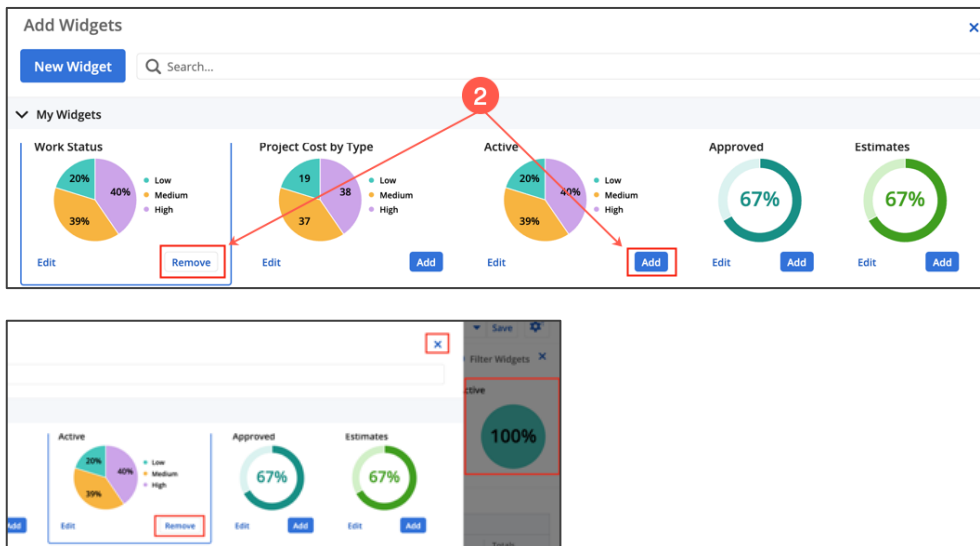
Add/Remove Widgets to the Grid



1. Click Manage Widgets. The Add Widgets dialog box displays.



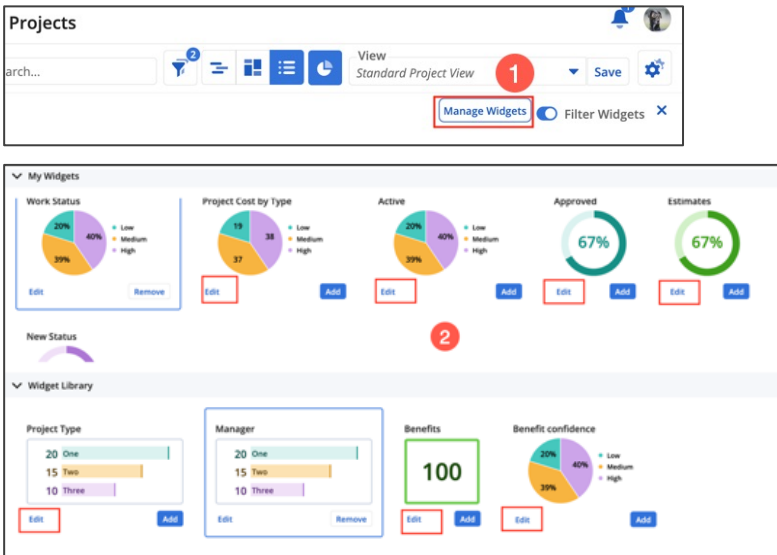
2. Click **Add/Remove** for any Widget you wish to add/remove from the Grid
 - a. The Widget is added to the Grid
 - b. The **Add/Remove** button toggles
3. Click **Close** (x)



Edit and Delete Widgets



1. Click **Manage Widgets**. The **Add Widgets** dialog box displays.



2. Click **Edit**
 - a. Update attributes
3. Click **Save**
 - a. The **Save** button is not enabled until you make a change to at least one attribute
4. Click **Delete** to delete the Widget
 - a. There is no 'confirm' or 'undo'. If you delete in error, you need to recreate the Widget
