 - Bob Cozzie seconded.
 - No discussion. The motion passes. The SCIP is approved.
 - Create SIEC's Legislative Working Group (SIEC Strategic Planning Committee)

 - 911 Status Presentation (Frank)
 - Moving from analog to digital – focused on the call maker to call taker capabilities
 - January 1, 2026, NG911 begins, goal to get all PSAPs integrated by the end of December 2026
 - Help with best practices – PSAPs can receive texts, images, video, real-time location data, etc. – communities will need to shape the common operating picture
 - Report from SWI on Grant Reviews (Jeff)
 - 22 HSGP grant requests came in – SWIC Team reviewed applications to determine if the project is viable to go through the rest of the grant process.
 - Allocation grants were submitted
 - Federal Support Status Update (Jon and William)
