

Monitoring Report

*Timely Processing of Pandemic Unemployment Assistance Initial Claims
Filed on or before Dec. 26, 2020*

Date of Report: July 1, 2021

Summary:

The Oregon Employment Department has a goal of processing at least 80% of initial claims for Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) benefits within 21 calendar days of the claim being filed.

Performance:

The Oregon Employment Department has processed 96.18% of all PUA applications filed on or before Dec. 26, 2020. The remaining 3.82% are either duplicate applications (1.88%) or instances where the application was placed on hold and requires additional review (1.94%). Of the PUA initial claims processed, 36.08% were processed within 21 days of the claim being filed.

PUA applications filed prior on or before Dec. 26, 2020:

*Duplicate application refers to instances where applicants filed more than one PUA application and the duplicate application has not yet been processed.
