RULE TITLE: Rules Procedure

RULE SUMMARY: This is a housekeeping change to the Oregon Employment Department's Administrative Rules Procedures to reflect how modern technology has changed the way notice is given to the public. Currently, the most efficient system to notify newspapers of any agency news is FlashAlert Newswire, which sends the information to a large number of local, national, and international news organizations. The revised administrative rule purposefully does not specify the way in which our agency furnishes notice because technology is changing so rapidly and in the future, there may be other ways that become more efficient than FlashAlert Newswire.

The specific news agencies are being removed in an effort to account for the rapidly changing news environment. By saying a "news agency" notices will continue to be sent to news agencies like the Associated Press and those in the Capitol Press Room who are able to widely distribute the information so that the public and other interested parties have the opportunity to comment on all administrative rulemaking procedures.

RULE TEXT:

Prior to the adoption, amendment, or repeal of any permanent rule, the Employment Department shall give notice of the proposed adoption, amendment, or repeal:

- (1) In the Secretary of State's Bulletin referred to in ORS 183.360 at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the effective date.
- (2) By providing a copy of the notice to persons on the Employment Department's mailing list established pursuant to ORS 183.335(7) at least twenty-eight (28) days prior to the effective date.
- (3) By providing a copy of the notice to the legislators specified in ORS 183.335(15) of this section at least 49 days before the effective date.
- (4) By providing a copy of the notice to news agencies, to a newspaper of statewide circulation, and other members of the media who have requested notification.
