Oregon Residential Specialty Code – Chapter 11

- Executive Order 20-04 and HB 3409 (2023)
 - > Set 2029 ORSC target from 2005 ORSC
 - 60% reduction of <u>regulated</u>, <u>site</u> energy load
 - > 2023 ORSC
 - Approximately 51% reduction
 - > 2026 ORSC Target
 - Between 51% and 60% reduction
 - Integrated Draft/Base Code target: 54-55%



What changes will get us to the 2026 ORSC target?

2026 ORSC Adoption *Draft* **Timeline**

- April thru June New "2026 ORSC Working Group"
 - Develop <u>Integrated Draft</u> of <u>Chapter 11</u> ("Base Code")
- Early June Residential and Manufactured Structures Board (RMSB) Code Committee member solicitation
 - > Application open to *all stakeholders*
 - RMSB determines makeup and balance
 - Between 5 and 9 members



2026 ORSC Adoption *Draft* Timeline

- July 9 RMSB Meeting
 - Board appoints Code Committee members
 - Sets Base Code (2024 IRC & ORSC Ch. 11 Integrated Draft)
 - 2024 IECC is <u>NOT</u> the "Base Code" for ORSC Chapter 11 Code Development
- Mid-July to Mid-August 2026 ORSC proposal period
 - Modifications to Ch 11 "Base Code" submitted to BCD



2026 ORSC Adoption *Draft* Timeline

- Sept thru November RMSB Code Committee Meetings
 - Number of meetings varies, between 3 and 5
 - > Sometimes Ch. 11 specific meetings occur
 - RMSB Code Committee meetings are open to all
- January/February 2026 RMSB Meeting
 - Review, approve, and/or modify and approve, RMSB Code Committee recommendations



2026 ORSC Adoption *Draft* **Timeline**

- Spring 2026 Construction Industry Energy Board (CIEB)
 Meeting & Rulemaking Hearing
- October 1, 2026 Anticipated Effective Date
- April 1, 2027 Anticipated Mandatory Date

Six-Month "Phase-In Period" allows for both 2023 ORSC and 2026 ORSC to be utilized



2026 ORSC Integrated Draft of Chapter 11

- "Working Group" Formulation Formal request <u>TODAY</u>
 - Operate similar to WA integrated draft process
 - Open to all stakeholders
 - Targets a balanced representation across industries
 - BCD will produce initial Rough Draft of Ch. 11 for discussion
 - Approximately 3 Meetings
 - Late April/Early May History, Principles, Process, Big Ideas
 - May Develop Integrated Draft (Approximately two meetings)



2026 ORSC Integrated Draft of Chapter 11

- Why an Integrated Draft/Base Code for Ch. 11?
 - Form collaborative basis for achieving target reductions
 - > Address home size & affordability, and other "big ideas"
 - > Set *expectations* for 2026 ORSC Code Change proposals
 - > Engage all affected stakeholders
 - Stakeholder collaboration will reduce effort by BCD Staff, RMSB Code Committee, and RMSB
