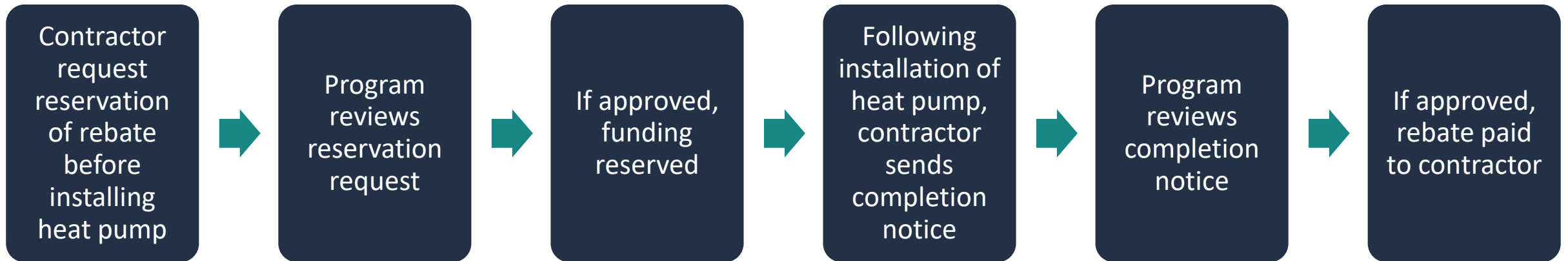
PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Financial assistance for the purchase and installation of heat pumps and related upgrades.

- ▶ Assistance available to owners of:
 - Rental units – does not include vacation occupancy or transient occupancy in hotel or motel.
 - Manufactured dwellings or recreational vehicles that rent a space in a manufactured dwelling or RV park.
- ▶ Eligible contractors apply online to reserve and request funds. The full rebate amount is passed on to the customer.

- ▶ ACCA Manuals J and S provide guidance for right-sizing of heat pump unit
 - Alternate standards used must amount to “equivalent energy efficiency industry standards for sizing equipment” as determined by ODOE
