## **Application Instructions.**

- 1. Read Opportunity Announcement 25-079, including all references therein.
- 2. Review all Applicant Resources on the right side of the <u>program website</u>.
- 3. Download the Project Summary Form and complete the form with details for an eligible project.

It is recommended to download the Project Summary Form and open with a PDF application such as Adobe Acrobat Reader, Foxit PDF Reader, or Apple Preview. The form may not function properly if opened in a web browser.

- 4. Prepare a single file with a map, maps or diagrams of the project area for uploading.
- 5. Complete the application process by uploading the project form and the map file at the ODOE Customer Service Portal.

Although not part of the application, please review the details of the following requirements of a grant agreement with ODOE and ensure your organization will comply before applying:

- a. Submitting false or misleading information in connection with this application may result in the application or organization being found ineligible for financial assistance under this program. Receiving public grant funds because of false representations constitutes an act of fraud.
- b. ODOE must be notified if your organization has applied for a grant under IIJA Section 40101(c), Grid Resilience and Innovation Partnerships Program (GRIP), FOA 2740, or any federal grant program for the same project.
- c. Compliance with all conditions of the program is required if funding is awarded, including any ODOE or USDOE audits and site inspections before or after grants are awarded and disbursed.
- d. Compliance with all Davis-Bacon Act requirements as determined by subchapter IV of Chapter 31 of Title 40, United States Code.
- e. Compliance with, or waivers granted to, the Build America Buy America Requirement, per Section 70914 of the IIJA.
- f. Compliance with the federal law and regulations, and other requirements listed and referenced in the opportunity announcement on the State and Federal program websites.
