
## Oregon Grid Resilience Grant Program

Electric utilities are eligible to apply for grants to support resilience projects, which can include weatherization technologies and equipment, fire-resistant technologies and fire-prevention systems, utility pole management, undergrounding of electrical equipment, and more.

Strengthening the resilience of the electric grid can reduce disruptive events, like power outages due to extreme weather. ODOE's program is designed to fund projects that will have the greatest community benefits while addressing the most pressing grid resilience needs.



At least 40 percent of ODOE's grant budget is reserved for small utilities – which often serve rural areas of the state – that sell less than 4 million megawatt hours of electricity per year.
