

## Oregon Rental Home Heat Pump Program Affordable Housing Provider Eligibility – Option 1

In order to qualify for a rebate offered under the program for affordable housing providers, the owner of the dwelling where the installation will be located must provide proof of eligibility. Proof of eligibility must be provided in one of three ways.

Option 1: The owner provides proof they are currently qualified under one or more of the following programs administered by Oregon Housing and Community Services, or they are participating in the Housing Choice Voucher Program at the rental housing where the heat pump will be installed.
