Option 2: Pursuant to OAR 330-240-0060(2), a homeowner is eligible for an increased solar incentive if the homeowner is determined eligible one of the following one of the following Oregon DHS or OHA programs. "Household" means all individuals who reside in the place of residence, including all family members and roommates who are not related and not part of a separate lease agreement. Further, the homeowner attests that this declaration of household size is true and correct. Homeowner Attestation of Authentic Documentation Provided By signing, the homeowner attests that the Eligibility Notice provided with this form to the Oregon Department of Energy is true, correct and authentic. Furthermore, the homeowner acknowledges that if the document content has been altered, or the Household Size falsified, the Department may order the revocation of the rebate and may pursue appropriate legal action against the homeowner as appropriate. - 4. Combine the contract PDF with the Attestation form PDF and Eligibility Notice PDF.
- 5. Upload the combined PDF to ODOE PowerClerk on Step 4 of the Reservation Request.
