Low- and Moderate-Income Residential Household Eligibility – Option 3

Option 3: Pursuant to OAR 330-240-0060(1), a homeowner is eligible for an increased solar incentive if the household can provide proof of eligibility. To prove qualifying income, the homeowner shall provide an Oregon Department of Revenue tax transcript for each income recipient residing at the household physical address. Transcript(s) for tax year 2019 are preferred but tax year 2018 is/are also acceptable.

Form Instructions:

1. Fill out form completely and acquire signature (electronic signatures are acceptable).
2. Save the signed Eligibility attestation form as a PDF.
3. Scan the Tax Transcript to a PDF.
4. Combine the contract PDF with the Attestation form PDF and Tax Transcript PDF into one PDF.
5. Upload the combined PDF to ODOE PowerClerk on Step 4 of the Reservation Request.

To qualify as a household with low- or moderate-income, the sum of all incomes in the household must be at or below the amounts listed below, by household size. All income earners residing at the place of residence, including all family members and roommates who are not related and not part of a separate lease agreement.
