Honorable Secretary Granholm,

The Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE) appreciates the efforts of the United States Department of Energy to re-evaluate the definitions and energy efficiency standards for General Service Lamps (GSLs). ODOE also appreciates the opportunity to provide comment on this potential activity.

Product energy efficiency standards, including GSL standards, benefit consumers by saving energy, reducing costs, and reducing GHG emissions. Federal standards provide consistency in the marketplace, and enhance equity by ensuring widespread access to efficient products for all consumers. **As such, ODOE urges the United States Department of Energy to promptly move forward with implementing the expanded GSL definitions from January 2017, as well as the efficiency standard update to 45 lumens per watt** that was previously due to become effective in January 2020 but has not yet been implemented.
