Updates to the Go Electric Oregon Website

The objective of updating the goelectric website is to improve the overall user experience of the webpage, including:

- Ensuring the information provided on the website meets user expectations and needs
- Ensuring the external resources identified throughout the website are accurate and thorough
- Updating the website structure for more user-friendly navigation to different portions of the site
- Identifying gaps in EV-related information that could be included

Updates to the EV Dashboard

The objective of updating the EV dashboard is to add to and improve the type of information contained in the dashboard. The information contained is intended to support organizations, businesses, and local community activities to increase EV adoption, including:

- Demographic, geographic, and other EV registration data breakdowns
- Types of passenger vehicle platforms Oregonians are driving
- Geographic accessibility to high-powered DC fast chargers
- Information on EV adoption in the medium- and heavy-duty sectors
- Cost differences between EVs and internal combustion vehicles
- GHG emissions reductions associated with EV adoption

Updates to the Governor's EV Leadership Awards

To celebrate Oregon EV leaders, Governor Brown issues EV Leadership awards each year. Currently, the program honors auto dealers who help Oregonians make the switch from internal combustion engines to electric, and businesses and organizations that support EV adoption through charging infrastructure and fleet conversion. The objective of this discussion is to hear ideas for updates to the EV Leadership Award categories to ensure the awards cover a broad spectrum of public and private entities working to increase EV adoption and improve overall awareness of and participation in the award nomination process.
