BONANZA ENERGY FACILITY)	AS SPECIAL ADVISORY GROUP

On August 7, 2020, the Oregon Department of Energy received the Notice of Intent to submit an application for site certificate for the proposed Bonanza Energy Facility. The applicant is Hecate Energy Bonanza LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of Hecate Energy NAF LLC. The proposed facility would be located in Klamath County, near the town of Bonanza.

ORS 469.480(1) requires the Energy Facility Siting Council to designate as a special advisory group the governing body of any local government within whose jurisdiction a facility is proposed to be located. The governing body of Klamath County is the Klamath County Board of Commissioners.

Therefore, it is ordered that the Klamath County Board of Commissioners is appointed as the special advisory group to advise the Energy Facility Siting Council in any site certificate proceedings for the Bonanza Energy Facility.
