1 The Energy Facility Siting Council (EFSC or Council) appointed Kate Triana, Senior
2 Administrative Law Judge with Oregon Office of Administrative Hearings as the hearings
3 officer for the proceedings of the Application for Site Certificate for the Nolin Hills Wind
4 Power Project on February 1, 2022. On December 13, 2022, the Oregon Department of
5 Energy (Department) was notified that Ms. Triana needed to be replaced to cover the
6 matter due to other OAH business demands.

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8 The Council is authorized under ORS 469.470 to appoint a hearing officer for such
9 purposes as necessary to carry out its duties. The Council is required to appoint a
10 hearing officer to conduct a contested case proceeding on behalf of the Council
11 pursuant to OAR 345-015-0023. The Council further finds that a hearing officer will be
12 needed to continue presiding over the contested case proceeding on the Department’s
13 proposed order on the Nolin Hills Wind Power Project, as required by OAR 345-015-
14 0230.

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16 THEREFORE, Council appoints Ms. Allison Greene Webster, a Senior Administrative Law
17 Judge with the Oregon Office of Administrative Hearings, as the replacement hearing
18 officer for the review of the Nolin Hills Wind Power Facility site certificate application
19 and all future project proceedings, subject to the intergovernmental agreement
20 between the Department and OAH. Ms. Greene Webster has a J.D. from Loyola Law
21 School in Los Angeles.
