On March 9, 2023, the Department received a Notice of Intent for a proposed 230-kV transmission line, the Lone Pine to Whetstone Transmission Line Project. The applicant is PacifiCorp. The proposed facility would be located in Jackson County, near the City of Medford. The applicant is PacifiCorp. The proposed transmission line would connect to two substations located in the communities of Lone Pine and Whetstone.

ORS 469.480(1) requires the Energy Facility Siting Council to designate as a special advisory group the governing body of any local government within whose jurisdiction a facility is proposed to be located. The governing body of Jackson County is the Jackson County Board of Commissioners.

Therefore, it is ordered that the Jackson County Board of Commissioners is appointed as the special advisory group to advise the Energy Facility Siting Council in any site certificate proceedings for the Lone Pine to Whetstone Transmission Line Project.
