Leaning Juniper IIA Request for Amendment 3 Draft Proposed Order (Public Hearing) The project is an operational 90.3 megawatt (MW) wind energy generation facility, located within a site boundary of 6,404 acres. The facility consists of 43 wind turbines, with a maximum blade tip height of 492 feet.

- B. (6:00 P.M.) Wheatridge Renewable Energy Facility East Request for Amendment 1 Draft Proposed Order (Public Hearing) The project is an approved, but not yet-constructed, 200-megawatt (MW) wind energy generation facility. It is approved to include up to 66 wind turbines, up to 32 miles of two overhead, parallel 230 kV transmission lines, and other related and supporting facilities to be located within an approximately 4,582-acre site boundary in Umatilla and Morrow Counties

Council will consider information presented on Revision 9 to the Security Plan for the Trojan Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) presented at the February 23, 2024, Council meeting, and will consider whether the revised plan contains adequate provisions to ensure the protection and public health and safety pursuant to ORS 469.430 and OAR chapter 345, division 070.
- **F.** Public Comment Period (Information Item) This time is reserved for the public to address the Council regarding any item within Council jurisdiction that is not otherwise closed for comment.
- **G.** Boardman Solar Termination of Site Certificate (Action Item) Todd Cornett, Assistant Director for Siting and Council Secretary. The project is an approved but not yet constructed 75 megawatt (MW) solar PV facility located within a site boundary of 798 acres. Construction was not started as of

February 23, 2024, as required by condition GEN-GS-01, therefore the site certificate has expired. Council will evaluate the Department's request to terminate the site certificate.
