Roll Call and Opening Remarks

- A. Consent Calendar (Action Item & Information Item)** – Approval of March 21, 2025 minutes; Council Secretary Report; and other routine Council business.
- B. Muddy Creek Energy Park Notice of Intent Extension Request (Action Item)** – Chase McVeigh-Walker, Senior Siting Analyst. Council will review a request to extend the expiration of the Notice of Intent by one year, to May 19, 2026. The Muddy Creek Energy Park is a proposed 199 megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic power generation facility in Linn County.
- C. Battery Storage Technology Overview (Information Item)** – Tom Jackman, Rules Coordinator will present Council with the latest technology for battery energy storage systems.
- D. Public Comment Period (Information Item)** – This time is reserved for the public to address the Council regarding any item within Council jurisdiction that is not otherwise closed for comment. Obsidian Solar Center Amendment 2 Draft Proposed Order is closed for comment.

Per OAR 345-011-0020 the Chair establishes the duration of the time for individual commenters at 7 minutes but may lengthen or shorten that timeframe as the length of the meeting and timing and duration of other Council business dictate.

E. Role of Electricity Transmission in the Energy Transition (Information Item) – Jason Sierman, Senior Policy Analyst will provide Council an overview of the need to increased transmission to achieve economy-wide decarbonization.

F. Department of Land Conservation and Development Update on Farm Impacts Test (OAR 660-033-0130(5) (Information Item) – Hilary Foote, Department of Land Conservation and Development Farm and Forest Specialist, will present to Council the changes to the farm impacts test under OAR 660-033-0130(5), applicable to energy facilities located in Exclusive Farm Use zoned land, recently adopted, effective as of January 1, 2025.

G. Soil and Structural Standard Update (Information Item) – Sarah Esterson, Senior Policy Advisor, will provide Council an overview of the Soil Protection and Structural Standards; new data, policy, guidance and information and plan requirements.
