1 BGTF Speedway Project, LLC submitted an application for a site certificate (ASC) for a
2 proposed wind and solar power generation facility to be known as Speedway Energy
3 Facility. The proposed energy facility would be in Sherman County, Oregon.

4
5 The Energy Facility Siting Council (Council) is authorized under Oregon Revised Statute
6 (ORS) 469.470 to appoint a hearing officer for such purposes as necessary to carry out
7 its duties. The Council is required to appoint a hearing officer to conduct a contested
8 case proceeding on behalf of the Council pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR)
9 345-015-0320.

11 The Council finds that a hearing officer will be needed to conduct a contested case
12 proceeding on the proposed order on the ASC for the proposed Speedway Energy
13 Facility, as required by OAR 345-015-0320.

15 The Council finds that Bradley Schmidt, J.D., Oregon Office of Administrative Hearings, is
16 qualified and capable to serve as hearing officer for the ASC proceedings of the
17 proposed Speedway Energy Facility.

19 THEREFORE, the Council hereby appoints Bradley Schmidt, J.D., as the hearing officer for
20 such purposes as necessary for the hearings and proceedings of the Speedway Energy
21 Facility ASC, subject to the intergovernmental agreement between the Oregon
22 Department of Energy and the Oregon Office of Administrative Hearings.
