Notice of Proposed Order on Request for Amendment 6

Summary:

Date Notice Issued: January 20, 2021

<u>Staff Recommendation</u>: In the proposed order staff recommends the Energy Facility Siting Council (EFSC) approve RFA6 and grant an amended site certificate, subject to existing and recommended amended conditions.

<u>Site Certificate Amendment Request</u>: Construction completion deadline extension; modify micrositing corridor area; and amend previously imposed site certificate conditions.

Facility Location: Sherman County

<u>Amendment Review</u>: This amendment request is being processed under Type B review which does not include an opportunity to request a contested case proceeding.

Description of Facility (Under

Construction/Approved): The Golden Hills Wind Project is approved to include up to 400 megawatts (MW) of wind energy facility components (up to 125 wind turbines with a maximum blade tip height of 650 feet) within a 29,500 acre site boundary in Sherman County. The facility is approved to be developed in phases. The first phase, currently under construction, includes an Operations and Maintenance building. The remaining approved facility components must be constructed by June 18, 2021, unless extension of the construction completion deadline is approved by Council through review of the amendment request. **Proposed Changes in Amendment Request:** RFA6 seeks Council approval to extend the construction completion deadline by 18 months from June 18, 2021 to December 31, 2022; add approximately 534 acres to the facility micrositing corridor to adjust the final location of access roads and collector lines; and amend preconstruction conditions to align with phased construction schedule, modify language of 9 previously imposed site certificate conditions related to the Council's Historic, Cultural, and Archeological standard and 1 previously imposed site certificate condition related to the Council's Fish and Wildlife Habitat standard.

Facility Location: The Golden Hills Wind Project is located in Sherman County, between the cities of Wasco and Moro, both east and west of U.S. Highway 97. A map of the facility site boundary is included in this notice. EFSC Review Process: The amendment request is being processed under "Type B" review, per OAR 345-027-0368 and -0372. The proposed order considers all comments received on the record of the draft proposed order within EFSC jurisdiction. The proposed order recommends approval of the changes proposed in RFA6 and issuance of an amended site certificate. EFSC will review the proposed order at its January 22, 2021 meeting to be held remotely with opportunity for attendance via teleconference (phone) or WebEx (internet log-in). EFSC, may adopt, modify or reject the proposed order based on the considerations described in OAR 345-027-0375. In a written final order, EFSC shall either grant or deny issuance of an amended site certificate. Judicial review of Council's final order granting or denying the amendment request is as described in OAR 345-027-0372(5) and Oregon Revised Statute 469.403. 


Figure 1: Golden Hills Wind Project – Site Boundary and Proposed Expanded Micrositing Corridor Areas
