## Re: Request for Amendment 2 for the Boardman to Hemingway Transmission Line Project

Dear Ms. Tardaewether,

Idaho Power Company (Certificate Holder), a wholly owned subsidiary of IDACORP, Inc. is requesting an amendment to the Boardman to Hemingway Transmission Line Project (Project) Site Certificate. The Project consists of approximately 300 miles of high-voltage electric transmission line between the proposed Longhorn Station near Boardman, Oregon, and the Hemingway Substation in southwestern Idaho.

IPC is submitting this Request For Amendment 2 (RFA 2) to amend the site boundary/micrositing area approved in the Site Certificate to accommodate: (a) 11 transmission line alternatives based on IPC's coordination and agreement with the affected landowners; (b) refinement of the location of temporary work areas and roads resulting from additional design and engineering review; and (c) expansion of the Site Boundary, <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> mile each side of the transmission line and road centerline as described previously in a letter to you dated December 7, 2023.

Idaho Power has been working with individual landowners on finding suitable locations for temporary multi-use areas. After consultation with the Oregon Department of Energy and the respective counties, Idaho Power will no longer seek a site boundary adjustment for MUA UM-07, UN-05, UN-07, and MA-08.

The Certificate Holder submits RFA 2 pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 345-027-0350(4)(c) or "Type A" amendment review process because IPC is proposing to design, construct, and operate a portion of the Project in a manner that is different from the description in the Site Certificate and because IPC is requesting changes to several site certificate conditions.
